

Purchases in 2012:

- A total of £3,000 spent on:
- Funds for uniform and fees to support two bright and able girls to go on to secondary school
- Furniture, books and resources for the new library
- Big Books and sets of supporting reading books for the Grade 1 pupils so they can learn to read in English quicker
- Costs of places for 10 pupils to go on a school residential to develop social skills and learn more about their geographical area and their surrounding communities
- The costs of setting up, and training staff to use, 4 Interactive Whiteboards, paid for by the charity. [The IWBs give teachers access to a huge range of interactive teaching materials so more pupils are interested and engaged in learning]
- Materials to provide 'mini whiteboards' for pupils to use in lessons so more can answer questions in class and show they understand what is being taught
- Costs to replace the outdoor play equipment for the Reception age children
- Maps and display posters for geography lessons
- Costs of setting up a 'Magic Room' [a quiet, calming room] to provide small groups and 1:1 support for pupils who can't settle easily in a large class [usually of around 40-45 pupils]
